David,

I don't want to violate any ethical standards by sharing confidential information between two potentially competing grantees, but the fact that Ecology is being mentioned in two proposals that may be submitted to NRCS for the Conservation Innovation Grant RFP round that closes March 2 is making me very concerned. This second potential proposal I just learned about involves the WA Dairy Federation (Jay Gordon) and the WSU's Livestock & Poultry Learning Center (Prof. Joe Harrison). I am thinking you may want to contact them and find out if your two proposals could align so that Ecology is not stretched across two potentially competing proposals for launching a nutrient trading program.

Kelly Susewind was the Ecology person copied in the email exchange I was just forwarded, so you may want to start with him, but I also suggest you contact Jay Gordon, whose been a big advocate of linking water quality trading with manure management and biodigesters and whose idea it was to submit this proposal
