As we discussed, you will go ahead and replace any references to "regulatory guidance" with "multi-state agency guidance" so that it is clear that it is guidance the states are writing for themselves to follow. In turn, I've tried to insert where I could in the proposal that US EPA's role will be to provide regulatory oversight in the states' development of that guidance. I also provided some other editorial suggestions - all as comments so that you can best deal with them in your version control process.
