Carrie,

I'm providing my comments (in track changes) on the Workshop #2 Meeting Summary and the Guiding Principles. I'm copying the EPA Team to hopefully inspire them to also look at the documents and provide timely comments to you as well (and to copy me when they do).

Rather than mess with your format, I am providing a suggestion here for the Guiding Principles document. You are using roman numerals to emphasize the specific key principles for trading. However, it made less sense to me to continue to use those roman numerals for each circumstance where trading is not supported because it gives each one too much emphasis. How about making that overall statement about where trading is not supported roman numeral V, and then each circumstance after that follows the sub-category numeration?

And I still owe you the one from Workshop #1 because I want to spend more time reading that one through carefully. I'd also like to have our EPA attorney Kelly Gable look at it but her time is pretty booked for the next few weeks, so you may get some comments from her after your July 12 deadline.
