Musa,

I'm sorry to complicate this further but that is considerably more than our meal per diem (\$46/day), and I just confirmed with our travel person that we would not be able to get that additional cost approved. Since there is no other way for us to pay for the meals except through our travel budget, the only alternative I can identify is to have WP cover that for

us. It would require a letter like the ones we've used before, except this would only have the meals being provided to us at your expense, since the hotel cost was not a problem. I would need the letter soon so I can get the ethics forms through our approval system in time.

The EPA people who will be eating the meals are: Claire Schary, Susan Poulosom, Dustan Bott, and Bill Stewart. I am trying to get a final decision from Christine Psyk if she will be attending the meeting. She's on travel today and tomorrow but she may respond to my email anyway. Laurie Mann will not be attending nor will Dru Keenan.
